



Dr. Tawfiq Nasser is the Chief Executive Officer of Augusta Victoria Hospital in Jerusalem. He is a member of the American College of Health Care Executives and a member of the American Society for Clinical Pathology.

He is a member of the National Health Policy and Planning Committee at the Palestinian Ministry of Health. He is also a member of the Arab Health Policy Forum. He is the Coordinator of the East Jerusalem Hospital Network representing six Palestinian hospitals in East Jerusalem. Dr. Nasser served as the General Secretary of the National Health Reform Taskforce, a cabinet appointment in the ninth government.

Dr. Tawfiq Nasser received his education and training in the biomedical sciences (clinical immunology) in the USA. His clinical area of interest was immunologic obstetrics and the investigations of the immunology of the feto-maternal interface. His work also included studies on the immunology of ectopic pregnancy and the behavior of Lymphocytes during pregnancy. He was published in several American peer-reviewed medical journals in the USA. He worked in one of Virginia's largest health care systems (Sentara Health System) as well as with Physicians for Peace (Norfolk, Virginia). He returned to the West Bank in 1995 after the start of the Oslo peace process.
